Diagnosis

Reversed Calcaneal Spur

Discussion

Reversed calcaneus spur is a transient developmental anomaly that usually disappears by one year of age. It is seen equally in males and females.

Findings

CR-Triangular osseous spur emanating from the posterior plantar aspect of the calcaneus.
